

Tax Time!

Using the following clues, can you figure out the first and last names of the men (Ralph, Taylor, and William) and women (Susan and Vanessa), their jobs, and how they filed their taxes last year (using a local CPA, filing by mail, filing online, using a national tax service, or filing by telephone)?

1. William and Ms Jones had professionals file for them; the other filers chose to file their tax returns themselves.
2. Ms Noble (the cosmetologist) did not have a computer so she could not file online (but Mr McArthur did).
3. Ralph and the dentist (who is not Mr King) chose not to file through the mail; they filed online and over the phone, although not necessarily in that order.
4. Vanessa gave her tax information to a national tax service before she went on her shift as an EMT, and the return was finished the next morning.
5. Mr King and Susan had been considering sharing a building for their similar businesses, but when one of them asked his/her CPA, the advisor told the client there wouldn't be any tax savings.
6. Mr Lewis (an attorney) and Taylor work across the street from each other, and they also use the services of the barber (who is not Mr McArthur).
