

LAW SCHOOL CHOICES

Two female law students (Brittany and Danielle) and three male law students (Abner, Carlos, and Edward) are each taking a single seminar. The class schedule is (a) Monday Wednesday and Friday mornings (MWF AM), (b) Monday Wednesday Friday afternoons (MWF PM), (c) Monday only, (d) Tuesday and Thursday mornings (TR AM), and (e) Tuesday and Thursday afternoons (TR PM). Following these clues, can you determine which person takes which seminar, at which time, and what their future plans may be (one may work for the government)?

- (1) Brittany, who hopes to work at a non-profit, did not choose the Trial Practice seminar.
- (2) Edward and the person taking Criminal Law had morning classes (one twice a week, the other three times, although not necessarily in that order).
- (3) Monday was a busy day with three people taking classes at some point in the day: the person taking the ADR seminar, Brittany, and Carlos (who did not choose the Real Estate seminar).
- (4) The woman who plans to go back to school after graduation had classes only one day a week.
- (5) While talking after class, the man in the Real Estate seminar (who wanted to be a solo practitioner) told Abner (who did not want to work for a big firm) that Abner's choice of Environmental Law may have been a better choice in this economy.
