## What's New in the Library?

- Extended exam access hours for the ASL Library continue until the end of finals. **Lexis:** Current 1Ls and 2Ls can go to

<http://www.lexisnexis.com/lawschool/tps/content.asp?pid=732> to register for full-use summer access for externships or unpaid legal jobs (please do so before June 1, or your access will be limited to job searching databases).

If you're graduating, go to the same web site listed above, and you'll have bar exam access to the LexisNexis database until August 1. At that time, your LexisNexis ID will expire permanently (so be sure to use up your rewards points before then!).

**Westlaw:** All students can log on to "My Home Page" on Westlaw's site (<http://lawschool.westlaw.com/>) and click on the big "Does your summer forecast call for Westlaw? Extend your Westlaw password this summer" box at the bottom center of the page. Do so before June 1!

- If you've got the time to form a band this summer, you may want to be careful who you let in, especially if you're in Australia. Members of Mental As Anything (their song "Live It Up" hit #2 on the AU charts in 1985) dismissed their drummer, claiming that he played "like a chimpanzee on speed."
